27 Patrol Vehicle

28 Chief Reizin presented his request for a replacement vehicle for the Ford Explorer which was  
29 damaged and totaled. A 2024 Chevrolet 1500 Silverado 4wd crew cab police package is available  
30 now for \$49,318.00. After discussion, the consensus of the board thought this was a good idea  
31 providing the other vehicle the Police Department has ordered be received at a later date when the  
32 new millage takes effect (After December 1, 2025). Payment for the Silverado would first come from  
33 the insurance money from the totaling of the Explorer, 2<sup>nd</sup> from the balance of the remaining ARPA  
34 funds and 3<sup>rd</sup> from 1/2 of the vehicle replacement fund. Clerk Goebel was excused at 11:25.
